

Section B:

Arrested and charged in Court but later dismissed or acquitted of charge[s]

Things you will need to complete this process:

- The necessary forms to request this action;
- A complete set of your fingerprints; and
- A clear understanding of the law in the matter. Carefully read ORS 137.225; and
- **NO** Court or District Attorney's Office filing fee.

PRIOR TO FILING

Forms - You may download a packet of forms to complete this process. They are also available in Room 104, located in the Benton County Courthouse. Ask for "Set Aside Section B." You may use these forms as examples to create your own, you may purchase copies at a stationery store, or you may use these as your originals to file your request. There should be three forms in the packet: the Motion to Set Aside Records of Arrest, Affidavit in Support of Motion to Set Aside Records of Arrest, and the Order to Set Aside and Seal Records of Arrest.

Complete the forms and have your signature on the Affidavit notarized, or the Court Clerk in Room 104 may witness your signature. **Do not sign the Affidavit until you are in the presence of a Notary or the Court Clerk**. Complete all the information on the Motion, Affidavit, and the Order. Use the case number in the previously filed criminal case on your forms.

Fingerprints - You will need to provide a complete set of your fingerprints. Information on getting your fingerprints taken is on the last page of this information packet.

Copies - In addition to the original forms that you will file with the Court, you are required to serve [give] the District Attorney's Office with a copy of the Motion and the Affidavit that you are filing with the Court. So, when you have completed the forms, make a copy of the Motion and the Affidavit. You may wish to make a copy for yourself as you will be filing the originals with the Court.

Service on the DA - When you have a complete set of your fingerprints, completed the forms, and made copies, take the District Attorney copies to their office located on the 3rd Floor of the Benton County Courthouse, 120 NW 4th Street, Corvallis, Oregon. With their copies, also provide the set of your fingerprints.

FILING YOUR PAPERS

Submit your original documents in the Benton County Courthouse, Room 104, located at 120 NW 4th Street, Corvallis, Oregon, or by mail to: Benton County Courthouse, PO Box 1870, Corvallis, Oregon 97339. Make sure that you have completed all the blanks on the Motion, Affidavit, and the Order, including your case number. Make sure that you have signed the Affidavit and have had your signature witnessed. The Clerk will assist you in filing your documents and take the required filing fee.

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

The District Attorney has a right to object to your request to have the records of your arrest set aside. They will send your fingerprints to the State Identification Bureau to confirm your identity and to see if there have been any other incidents that would cause them to want to object to your request. When the State Identification Bureau has completed their investigation, they will send the results back to the District Attorney. This process can take up to 90 days to complete. The Court will then decide, based on the information, whether to grant or deny your request. If the Court grants your request, a Judge will sign the Order that you submitted and order that copies be sent to those agencies that have your arrest records. The Court will also order that the Court file be sealed. You will be notified if the Court denies your request, or if a hearing will be scheduled to consider your Motion.
