1. I am _____ years of age. I have gone to school through _____ grade.

2. I know that I have the right to have a lawyer. If I do not have the money to hire a lawyer, the Judge will give me a lawyer at no cost to me subject to indigent defense guidelines.
 I have a lawyer I give up my right to have a lawyer

3. I understand what the charges are. I have been charged with: _____

4. I know that I may deny the charges against me and have a trial. If I deny the charges, the Constitution and other laws give me these rights:
 - a) I have the right to a quick and public trial to a judge. At the trial, the District Attorney must prove the charges beyond a reasonable doubt.
 - b) At the trial, I have a right to face in court and question all of the witnesses who testify against me.
 - c) I can bring witnesses to the trial to testify for me. I can use the Court's subpoena power to bring witnesses in and it won't cost me any money to do so.
 - d) I can testify if I want to, but the choice is up to me. If I choose not to testify, the judge cannot and will not use that against me.
 - e) I have the right to remain silent throughout these proceedings.
 - f) I have the right to have a lawyer help me throughout these proceedings.

5. I know that if I admit the charges against me, I give up my right to have a trial and the other rights listed above. After I admit, the Judge and only the Judge will decide what the disposition will be, but he/she will listen to suggestions from the Juvenile Department, the District Attorney, my lawyer if I have one, my parents and me. I know that the Judge can send me to a training school, youth correctional facility, residential treatment program or other out-of-home placement for _____ years and/or put me on probation and/or order me to go to detention if I

admit to the charges.

6. No one has promised me anything or threatened me to get me to admit to the charges. I am doing this of my own free will. It is my choice to admit rather than have a trial.
7. I understand that if I admit to a sex offense, I may have to submit to a blood draw for DNA purposes and I will have to register as a sex offender, possibly for the rest of my life.
8. I understand that if I am not a United States citizen, I may be deported, refused re-entry to the United States, or denied U. S. citizenship if I admit to these charges.
9. If I am on probation or parole, I understand that by admitting the charges in this case, my probation or parole may be revoked and I could be sent to a training school or youth correctional facility or residential treatment center or other out-of-home placement on the *old* charge added to the time I could go on these new charges.
10. I am not under the influence of any drugs, alcohol or inhalants.
