Under ORS 125.165 and 125.170 the presiding judge must establish the qualifications, standards and fees for court visitors;

It is hereby ordered that a court visitor shall meet the qualifications set forth in ORS 125.165 and have the appropriate education, training and experience to conduct interviews and make recommendations as required of court visitors under the law and have knowledge of the law relating to visitors and their duties and responsibilities:

It is further ordered that the judge in the Fifteenth Judicial District assigned to probate cases shall interview any person appointed to be a court visitor to assure the judge that the person meets the qualifications under the law and this order;

It is further ordered that the fee for a visitor is set at \$300.00 for each case plus necessary and reasonable expenses, including mileage, as set forth under the guidelines established for reimbursement of expenses for employees of the Oregon Judicial Department;

It is further ordered that the judge assigned to probate cases may allow a fee above \$300.00 for a case if the visitor establishes that such fee is necessary and reasonable because of its complexity.
