General Order 2010 -01

WHEREAS the court has determined that sharing certain dependency information from the Juvenile Court File is necessary for members of the Court's Zero To Three Team to evaluate potential eligibility and appropriateness for participation in the Zero To Three Program; and

WHEREAS ORS 419A.255(2) allows individuals acting under the Court's direction to view and share information on the youth's history.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT PURSUANT TO ORS 419A.255(2):

1. Upon receipt of youth's name for consideration to participate in the Zero To Three Court Program from any team member or attorney the Treatment Court Coordinator will share the Affidavit and/or Petition relating to the current placement of the youth with team members. If the child is already a ward of the court and the new affidavit and/or petition initiates consideration for the Zero To Three Program then the Treatment Court Coordinator may also share the basis of wardship from prior petition(s) with the team. The Drug and Alcohol team member will only receive this information if the Affidavit or Petition alleges drug and/or alcohol abuse/misuse or the child is currently a ward of the court and alcohol and drug issues were addressed in a prior petition that established wardship.
2. No other information from the court's file or any team member agency file, that is confidential in nature, may be shared by or with any team members without the proper releases of information being signed or under the Court's direction.
3. The information contained in the Affidavit and/or Petition may not be shared beyond the Team Members without proper releases in place.
