GENERAL ORDER #7

01/17/02

WHEREAS the Court has determined that Amended General Order #7 is in need of further amendment, and was first issued by the court on July 17, 1978, and was amended on April 22, 1982, February 19, 1993, and 12/28/01.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT PURSUANT TO ORS 419A.255:

- 1) The individual legal files of the Juvenile Court that are based **solely** on **JURISDICTION under ORS 419C.005** are open for public inspection.
- 2) The name of the child, the case number and the date, time and place of any juvenile court dependency hearing may be disclosed through the publication of daily court calendars of scheduled court proceedings.
- 3) The juvenile department is authorized to release information from an individuals' social file to the military service or to the Job Corps when requested by the subject of the file.
- 4) To release from an individual's social file the date of birth, residence, physical description and parents address of the juveniles to police agencies engaged in ongoing investigations and operations.
- 5) To release from an individuals social file their history and prognosis to other social agencies and superintendent of the school district in which the youth resides that the Director of the Juvenile Department determines has a legitimate interest upon the request of that agency.
- 6) Upon the request of any victim, their attorney or an insurance company representing the victim, the juvenile department is authorized to release from and individual's social file the name of the child, the parents and their address.
- 7) The juvenile department is authorized to release information from the **youth's** social file as outlined in ORS 419A.255(5), (6) and (7).
- 8) No other information from an individuals' social file may be released without written approval of the court.
