

Special notice from the Oregon Judicial Department:

NOTICE OF COURT FILING FEE CHANGES

EFFECTIVE January 1, 2008

Effective January 1, 2008, some circuit court filing fee amounts will change. Here is a recap of the changes:

Fee amount changes

- There is a new \$10 fee that applies to dissolutions, separations, annulments, and responses thereto filed on or after January 1, 2008.
- Under SMALL CLAIMS, the temporary surcharge amounts for a defendant denying a claim and claiming a right to a jury trial were corrected to \$3.

Domestic relations motion fee under ORS 21.111(3). Because there has been some confusion on this issue, please note that the motion fee under ORS 21.111(3) applies to all motions filed after entry of a judgment of marital annulment, dissolution, or separation, with a few limited exceptions. Prior to 2003, the ORS 21.111(3) fee was limited to modification motions entered one year after the entry of a decree. ORS 21.111(3) was amended by chapter 737, Oregon Laws 2003, section 12 (HB 2750) to remove these limitations.

Future Updates

Please note that the fee schedule will change again as of February 1, 2008, in compliance with Chief Justice Oder (CJO) 07-055 which adopts statutory fees for the filing of certain civil motions.
