It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Attempt to Commit a Class A Felony - Kidnapping in the First Degree**

Count number 1 , Attempt to Commit a Class A Felony - Kidnapping in the First Degree, 161.405(2)(b), Felony Class B, committed on or about 06/28/2012. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 05/29/2014.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is C.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Stipulation of the parties.

## **Incarceration**

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Dept of Corrections, for a period of 24 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson Sheriff for transportation to the Oregon Dept of Corrections for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served. Credit for time shall include any time in California served on this case. Defendant shall pay any extradition costs. The State may have 90 days to determine that amount.

The Defendant may be considered by the executing or releasing authority for any form of Reduction in Sentence, Conditional or Supervised Release Program, Temporary Leave From Custody, Work Release authorized by law for which the Defendant is otherwise eligible at the time of sentencing. The Defendant may be considered for release on post-prison supervision under ORS 421.508(4) upon successful completion of an alternative incarceration program.

## **Post-Prison Supervision**

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 3 year(s). If the Defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board.

### **Count 2 : Attempt to Commit a Class B Felony - Robbery in the Second Degree**

Count number 2 , Attempt to Commit a Class B Felony - Robbery in the Second Degree, 161.405(2)(c), Felony Class C, committed on or about 06/28/2012. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 05/29/2014.

## **Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 2 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is C.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Stipulation of the parties.

## **Incarceration**

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Dept of Corrections, for a period of 24 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson Sheriff for transportation to the Oregon Dept of Corrections for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served. Credit for time shall include any time in California served on this case. Defendant shall pay any extradition costs. The State may have 90 days to determine that amount.

The Defendant may be considered by the executing or releasing authority for any form of Reduction in Sentence, Conditional or Supervised Release Program, Temporary Leave From Custody, Work Release authorized by law for which the Defendant is otherwise eligible at the time of sentencing. For the reasons stated on the record, this sentence shall be consecutive to the sentence(s) on the following cases:

COUNT 1

### **Post-Prison Supervision**

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 3 year(s). If the Defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
