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It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1: Sexual Abuse 1.**

Count number 1, Sexual Abuse 1, ORS 163427, a Class B Felony, committed on or about 07/01/2002.

Conviction is based upon a plea of Guilty on 08/09/2004.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence pursuant to ORS 137.700

**Sentence Instructions**

Defendant shall:

- Not have contact with victim.
- Pay for victim counseling costs.

**Incarceration**

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Department of Corrections for a period of 75 month(s).

Defendant may receive credit for time served. Defendant may be considered by the executing or releasing authority for any form of alternative to incarceration or alternative sanctions as specified in ORS 137.750-137.752, and shall pay any required per diem fees.

It is ordered that the defendant serve a minimum of 75 month(s).

**Post-Prison Supervision**

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 10 year(s). If defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board.

- Pursuant to ORS 144.103, the length of post prison supervision shall equal the maximum statutory indeterminate sentence for the charge, minus any time incarcerated.

- The Money Judgment amounts are hereby made a part of this judgment and it is a recommendation that they be made a condition of post prison supervision.

### **Statutory Provisions**

Defendant is ordered to submit blood or buccal sample and thumbprint pursuant to ORS 137.076. Defendant is ordered to submit to testing for HIV and other communicable diseases pursuant to ORS 135.139.

### **Count 2: Sexual Abuse 1.**

Count number 2, Sexual Abuse 1, ORS 163427, a Class B Felony, committed on or about 04/09/2004.

Conviction is based upon a plea of Guilty on 08/09/2004.
