COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 2 : Assault in the Fourth Degree - Constituting Domestic Violence

Count number 2 , Assault in the Fourth Degree - Constituting Domestic Violence, 163.160(2), Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 08/12/2011. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 01/23/2014.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 2 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- Not have contact with victim Allison Guster or residence without prior permission from the court.
- Attend and participate with any counseling deemed appropriate by probation officer.
- Submit to polygraph examination by qualified examiner, at direction of probation officer to determine compliance to conditions of supervision; results are useable at revocation proceedings.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 45 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

COUNTS DISPOSED WITH NO CONVICTION

Count # 1 , Assault in the Fourth Degree is Dismissed.

Count # 3 , Harassment is Dismissed.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
