It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Possession of Methamphetamine

Count number 1 , Possession of Methamphetamine, 475.894, Felony Class C, committed on or about 04/22/2012. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/25/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 1 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is E.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 11 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):
Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Abstain from use or possession of controlled substances.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 3 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served. Time spent to apply.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

This sentence shall be concurrent with the following cases 121020FE, 121588FE and 122118FE..

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
