**COUNT(S)**

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Theft in the First Degree**

Count number 1 , Theft in the First Degree, 164.055, Felony Class C, committed on or about 04/10/2012. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/30/2013.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Attend and participate with any counseling deemed appropriate by probation officer.
- Abstain from use or possession of controlled substances.
- Not have contact with victim without prior permission from the court.
- Not have contact with victim's residence without the permission of the court.
- Complete 40 hours of community service. Immediately report to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501.
- Upon successful completion of probation, misdemeanor treatment of the charge may be requested.

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 90 sanction units with 30 jail units.
