It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants

Count number 1 , Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants, 813.010(5), Felony Class C, committed on or about 01/05/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 07/25/2014.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is C.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Durational Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

License Suspension / Revocation

Defendant's Drivers License is Revoked for Life.

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of County Jail, for a period of 8 month(s). Defendant is to report to Supervisory Authority by 08/04/2014 at 9:00 AM. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the Defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

Post-Prison Supervision

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 3 year(s). If the Defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board. The court recommends as a condition of post-prison supervision:
