**COUNT(S)**

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Forgery in the First Degree**

Count number 1 , Forgery in the First Degree, 165.013, Felony Class C, committed on or about 08/14/2012. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 04/10/2014.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with victim, Joe C. Moore, without prior permission from the court.
