Count number 3 , Assault in the Fourth Degree, 163.160(2), Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 01/26/2013. Conviction is based upon a No Contest Plea on 08/29/2013.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
