It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 2 : Harassment

Count number 2 , Harassment, 166.065(3), Misdemeanor Class B, committed on or about 02/07/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/31/2013.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 11 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- follow all requirements of restraining order as long as in effect

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 1 day(s). Defendant is to report to by 10/31/2013. Defendant may receive credit for time served. will not report credit from time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

This sentence shall be concurrent with the following cases 13cn00505 13cr00194.
