It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Robbery in the Third Degree

Count number 1 , Robbery in the Third Degree, 164.395, Felony Class C, committed on or about 02/24/2013. Conviction is based upon a No Contest Plea on 08/21/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 5 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is H.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 2 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Not have contact with victims Food 4 Less, Joshua Carr, or Myles Doshier without the written consent of probation officer.

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 120 sanction units with 60 jail units.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 20 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

For the reasons stated on the record, this sentence shall be consecutive to the sentence(s) on the following cases: 12-3851-CN

Count 4 : Assault in the Fourth Degree

Count number 4 , Assault in the Fourth Degree, 163.160(2), Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 02/24/2013. Conviction is based upon a No Contest Plea on 08/21/2013.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 2 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 20 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS
