- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not drive without valid permit, license and insurance.
- Obey all laws.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Enter and successfully complete alcohol/drug treatment as deemed appropriate by probation officer. Report to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501.
- Submit to random breath and urine testing if lawfully requested by a police officer.
- Attend Victims Impact Panel on 11/06/13

#### **Jail as a Condition of Probation**

Defendant is confined to jail for 2 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
