**COUNT(S)**

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Possession of Methamphetamine**

Count number 1, Possession of Methamphetamine, 475.894, Felony Class C, committed on or about 03/11/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 02/28/2014.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 1 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Upward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

### **Sentence Instructions**

Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- The length of post-prison supervision shall be 1 year(s). A violation of post-prison supervision conditions shall subject the defendant to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.
