COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 2 : Robbery in the Second Degree

Count number 2, Robbery in the Second Degree, 164.405, Felony Class B, committed on or about 03/21/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 05/21/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 2 is 9 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Per ORS 137.712 Exceptions to ORS 137.700 &/or 137.707

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

- Offender Cooperated With State

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 5 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with 7-11'S in Jackson County, without prior permission from the court.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
