It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 2 : Attempt to Commit a Class C/Unclassified Felony - Aggravated Harassment**

Count number 2, Attempt to Commit a Class C/Unclassified Felony - Aggravated Harassment, 161.405(2)(d), Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 04/19/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 11/18/2013.

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Not have contact with victim, per current restraining order, without prior permission from the court.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
