It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Felon in Possession of a Restricted Weapon

Count number 1, Felon in Possession of a Restricted Weapon, 166.270(2), Felony Class C, committed on or about 01/30/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/21/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Upward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

- Stipulation of the parties

Sentence Instructions

Defendant shall:

- Forfeit gun and/or weapon.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- The length of post-prison supervision shall be 2 years. A violation of post-prison supervision conditions shall subject the defendant to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.

COUNTS DISPOSED WITH NO CONVICTION

Count # 2, Possession of Marijuana is Dismissed.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
