**COUNT(S)**

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Burglary in the First Degree**

Count number 1, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 05/12/2013. Conviction is based upon a No Contest Plea on 08/23/2013.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is H.

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with victim's residence at 135 Fern Valley Road, Medford, without the written consent of probation officer.
- Refrain from knowingly associating with co-defendants or crime partners.
- Not have contact with victims Joy Taylor, Roberto Rodriguez-Herrera or their children without the written consent of probation officer.
- Attend and participate with any counseling deemed appropriate by probation officer.
- Obey all laws.

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 180 sanction units with 90 jail units.

**Jail as a Condition of Probation**

Defendant is confined to jail for 30 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

**Count 3 : Aggravated Animal Abuse in the First Degree**

Count number 3, Aggravated Animal Abuse in the First Degree, 167.322, Felony Class C, committed on or about 05/12/2013. Conviction is based upon a No Contest Plea on 08/23/2013.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 3 is 3 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 2 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):  
Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Obey all laws.
- Not have contact with victims Joy Taylor, Roberto Rodriguez-Herrera or their children without the written consent of probation officer.
- Not have contact with victim's residence at 135 Fern Valley Road in Medford without the written consent of probation officer.
- Not own or possess a domestic animal for 15 years.
- Attend and participate with any counseling deemed appropriate by probation officer.

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 90 sanction units with 30 jail units.

### **Jail as a Condition of Probation**

Defendant is confined to jail for 10 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

For the reasons stated on the record, this sentence shall be consecutive to the sentence(s) on the following cases: Count 1

### **COUNTS DISPOSED WITH NO CONVICTION**

Count # 2, Criminal Mischief in the First Degree is Dismissed.
