It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Interfering w/ Peace/Parole and Probation Officer

Count number 1, Interfering w/ Peace/Parole and Probation Officer, 162.247, Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 05/16/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 11/05/2013.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Name: Ashland Safeway and Residence at 550 East Main Street , Ashland Oregon Not have contact with victim without prior permission from the court.

- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Name: Ashland Safeway Not have contact with victim without prior permission from the court.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 5 day(s). Defendant is to report to Supervisory Authority by 11/07/2013 at 9:00 AM. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.
