It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Delivery of Methamphetamine

Count number 1, Delivery of Methamphetamine, 475.890(2), Felony Class B, committed on or about 05/16/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/27/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 4 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is E.

License Suspension / Revocation

Defendant's Drivers License is for 6 month(s).

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 2 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Obey all laws.
- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- Comply with all requirements of Drug Court.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 60 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may not receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

Count 2 : Possession of Methamphetamine

Count number 2, Possession of Methamphetamine, 475.894, Felony Class C, committed on or about 05/16/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/27/2013.

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- Comply with all requirements of Drug Court.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
