Count 3 : Burglary in the First Degree

Count number 3, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 03/04/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/10/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 3 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is F.
