It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 2 : Recklessly Endangering Another Person**

Count number 2, Recklessly Endangering Another Person, 163.195, Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 06/05/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/04/2013.

**License Suspension / Revocation**

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.

- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances

- Not have contact with victim Douglas Linn or Maria Para-Mecado without prior permission from the court.
- Not have contact with victim's residence without the permission of the court.
- No additional jail sanctions are imposed. Defendant to be given Credit for all time served on this case.
