COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 2 : Animal Abuse in the First Degree

Count number 2, Animal Abuse in the First Degree, 167.320(3), Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 06/05/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 11/21/2013.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 24 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Forfeit gun and/or weapon.
- Not possess weapons, firearms or dangerous animals.
- Possess no domestic animals for a period of 5 years.

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Not possess weapons, firearms or dangerous animals.
