Defendant appeared in person and was in custody. The court determined that the defendant was indigent for purposes of court-appointed counsel, and the court appointed counsel for the defendant. The defendant was represented by Attorney(s) LAURANCE W PARKER, OSB Number 882863. Plaintiff appeared by and through Attorney(s) MANDI L GOULD, OSB Number 040449.

**COUNT(S)**

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Burglary in the First Degree**

Count number 1, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 04/05/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/10/2013.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is E.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence per ORS 137.717

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

- Same as Optional Probation Criteria

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with victim without the written consent of probation officer.
- Not have contact with victim's residence without the written consent of probation officer.
- If selected, the defendant will comply with all requirements of treatment courts.
- Defendant stipulates to pay restitution on all count(s) and cases, including those dismissed.

**Jail as a Condition of Probation**

Defendant is confined to jail for 60 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may not receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

For the reasons stated on the record, this sentence shall be consecutive to the sentence(s) on the following cases: 12-6338-FE
