It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

**Count 1 : Tampering with a Witness**

Count number 1, Tampering with a Witness, 162.285, Felony Class C, committed on or between 04/30/2013 and 05/14/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/03/2013.

**Sentencing Guidelines**

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

**Probation**

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Attend and participate with any counseling deemed appropriate by probation officer.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Not have contact with victim without the written consent of probation officer.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Submit to polygraph examination by qualified examiner, at direction of probation officer to determine compliance to conditions of supervision; results are useable at revocation proceedings.
- CONTACT WITH CHILDREN PURSUANT TO DHS DIRECTIVES

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 180 sanction units with 90 jail units.
