It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Burglary in the First Degree

Count number 1, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 06/21/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/27/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is H.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 3 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- restitution on all counts including dismissed counts
restitution joint and several with convicted co defendants
- If selected, the defendant will comply with all requirements of treatment courts.

Count 6 : Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle

Count number 6, Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle, 164.135, Felony Class C, committed on or about 06/21/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/27/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 6 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is H.

- If selected, the defendant will comply with all requirements of treatment courts.

- Obey all laws.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
