COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Burglary in the First Degree

Count number 1, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 05/20/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/22/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is H.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Upward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

• STIPULATION OF PARTIES

Sentence Instructions

Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of County Jail, for a period of 12 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the Defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

Count number 2, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 05/21/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/22/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 2 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence per ORS 137.717

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Dept of Corrections, for a period of 24 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson Sheriff for transportation to the Oregon Dept of Corrections for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the executing or releasing authority for any form of Reduction in Sentence, Conditional or Supervised Release Program, Temporary Leave From Custody, Work Release authorized by law for which the Defendant is otherwise eligible at the time of sentencing. The Defendant may be considered for release on post-prison supervision under ORS 421.508(4) upon successful completion of an alternative incarceration program.

For the reasons stated on the record, this sentence shall be consecutive to sentence(s) imposed herein on Count(s) 1.

Post-Prison Supervision

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 3 year(s). If the Defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board.

Count 3 : Burglary in the First Degree

Count number 3, Burglary in the First Degree, 164.225, Felony Class A, committed on or about 05/23/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 08/22/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 3 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence per ORS 137.717

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Dept of Corrections, for a period of 24 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson Sheriff for transportation to the Oregon Dept of Corrections for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 4 is 7 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence per ORS 137.717

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Dept of Corrections, for a period of 24 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson Sheriff for transportation to the Oregon Dept of Corrections for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the executing or releasing authority for any form of Reduction in Sentence, Conditional or Supervised Release Program, Temporary Leave From Custody, Work Release authorized by law for which the Defendant is otherwise eligible at the time of sentencing. Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 9 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence per ORS 137.717

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Dept of Corrections, for a period of 18 month(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson Sheriff for transportation to the Oregon Dept of Corrections for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the executing or releasing authority for any form of Reduction in Sentence, Conditional or Supervised Release Program, Temporary Leave From Custody, Work Release authorized by law for which the Defendant is otherwise eligible at the time of sentencing. The Defendant may be considered for release on post-prison supervision under ORS 421.508(4) upon successful completion of an alternative incarceration program.

For the reasons stated on the record, this sentence shall be consecutive to sentence(s) imposed herein on Count(s) 2.

Post-Prison Supervision

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 1 year(s). If the Defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board.
