COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Burglary in the Second Degree

Count number 1, Burglary in the Second Degree, 164.215, Felony Class C, committed on or about 05/02/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/06/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with users of controlled substances.
- Refrain from knowingly associating with persons who use or possess controlled substances, or from frequenting places where such substances are kept or sold.
- Obey all laws.
- Submit to random blood, breath and urine testing at the direction of probation officer to determine compliance with conditions of supervision; results are useable at revocation proceedings.
- Submit to search by probation officer of person or premises pursuant to ORS 137.540(i).
- Enter and successfully complete alcohol/drug treatment as deemed appropriate by probation officer. Report to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501.
- Submit to random breath and urine testing if lawfully requested by a police officer.
- Attend and participate with any counseling deemed appropriate by probation officer.
- Not have contact with victim without the written consent of probation officer.
- Not have contact with victim's residence without the written consent of probation officer.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 90 sanction units with 30 jail units.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 10 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

Count number 2, Theft in the Second Degree, 164.045, Misdemeanor Class A, committed on or about 05/02/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/06/2013.

Sentence Instructions

Defendant shall:

- CONVICTION ONLY/NO FURTHER FINES, FEES OR SANCTIONS

Count 3 : Burglary in the Second Degree

Count number 3, Burglary in the Second Degree, 164.215, Felony Class C, committed on or about 05/03/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/06/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 3 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is F.

License Suspension / Revocation

Defendant's Driver License is not suspended.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with users of controlled substances.
- Abstain from use or possession of controlled substances.
- Refrain from knowingly associating with persons who use or possess controlled substances, or from

frequenting places where such substances are kept or sold.

- Obey all laws.
- Submit to random blood, breath and urine testing at the direction of probation officer to determine compliance with conditions of supervision; results are useable at revocation proceedings.
- Submit to search by probation officer of person or premises pursuant to ORS 137.540(i).
- Enter and successfully complete alcohol/drug treatment as deemed appropriate by probation officer. Report to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501.
- Submit to random breath and urine testing if lawfully requested by a police officer.
- Abstain from the use of intoxicants; do not consume or possess alcohol or non-prescribed controlled substances
- Not have contact with victim without the written consent of probation officer.
- Not have contact with victim's residence without the written consent of probation officer.
- No contact with Theft location without written permission from Probation Officer.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 20 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

For the reasons stated on the record this, sentence shall be consecutive to sentence(s) imposed herein on Count(s) 1 as well as sentence imposed on the following cases: 13CR02106.

COUNTS DISPOSED WITH NO CONVICTION

Count # 4, Theft in the Second Degree is Dismissed.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
