COUNT(S)

It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle

Count number 1, Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle, 164.135, Felony Class C, committed on or about 07/26/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 11/01/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is I.

License Suspension / Revocation

Defendant's Drivers License is Revoked for 1 year(s).

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with victim Grants Pass Irrigation district without prior permission from the court.
- Refrain from knowingly associating with co-defendants or crime partners.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 90 sanction units with 30 jail units.

Jail as a Condition of Probation

Defendant is confined to jail for 10 day(s). Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff for transportation to the Supervisory Authority for service of this sentence. Defendant may receive credit for time served.

The Defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and the defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

Count 2 : Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer

Count number 2, Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer, 811.540(1)(b)(A), Felony Class C, committed on or about 07/26/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 11/01/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 2 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is G.

License Suspension / Revocation

Defendant's Drivers License is Revoked for 1 year(s).

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)):

Defendant shall:

- Obey all laws.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Complete 80 hours of community service. Immediately report to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501.
- Not have contact with victim, Grants Pass irrigation without prior permission from the court.
- Refrain from knowingly associating with co-defendants or crime partners.

Pursuant to the sentencing guidelines grid, the Defendant is subject to 90 sanction units with jail units.

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
