It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer

Count number 1, Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer, 811.540(1)(b)(A), Felony Class C, committed on or about 07/26/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 09/04/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is E.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

Sentence Instructions

Defendant shall:

- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
