It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 2 : Assault in the Fourth Degree - Constituting Domestic Violence

Count number 2, Assault in the Fourth Degree - Constituting Domestic Violence, 163.160(3), Felony Class C, committed on or about 07/17/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/04/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 2 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is A.

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Durational Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

- STIPULATION OF PARTIES

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Bench Probation for a period of 2 year(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Not have contact with, Stephanie Shaw and Steven Dunn, victim without prior permission from the court.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Pay restitution on all count(s), including those dismissed.
- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.

Count 4 : Coercion

Count number 4, Coercion, 163.275, Felony Class C, committed on or about 07/20/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/04/2013.

Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Pay restitution on all count(s), including those dismissed.

Incarceration

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 6 is 6 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is A.

Sentence Instructions

Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
- Pay restitution on all count(s), including those dismissed.

- Pay restitution on all count(s), including those dismissed.

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Not have contact with, STEVEN DUNN, victim without prior permission from the court.
- Pay restitution on all count(s), including those dismissed.
- Pay restitution in an amount to be determined as ordered and pursuant to ORS 137.106(b). Defense stipulates the State does not need to detail the nature and amount of economic damages at this time.
