It is adjudged that the defendant has been convicted on the following count(s):

Count 1 : Theft in the First Degree

Count number 1, Theft in the First Degree, 164.055, Felony Class C, committed on or about 06/17/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/09/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 1 is 2 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is E.

This sentence is pursuant to the following special factors:

- Sentence per ORS 137.717

The court finds substantial and compelling reason for a Downward Dispositional Departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following aggravating or mitigating factor(s):

Probation

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Obey all laws.
- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody,

report within 24 hours of your release from jail.

- If selected, the defendant will comply with all requirements of treatment courts.

Count 3 : Possession of Methamphetamine

Count number 3, Possession of Methamphetamine, 475.894, Felony Class C, committed on or about 06/17/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/09/2013.

Sentencing Guidelines

The Crime Severity Classification (CSC) on Count Number 3 is 1 and the Criminal History Classification (CHC) is E.

Probation

Defendant is sentenced to Supervised Probation for a period of 18 month(s) and shall be subject to the following conditions of Probation:

Defendant is subject to all general conditions of probation (ORS 137.540).

Furthermore, Defendant is subject to the following Special Conditions of Probation (ORS 137.540(2)): Defendant shall:

- Comply with all conditions and procedures of accounting office regarding payment of fines, restitution and fees imposed. Abide by the financial conditions of probation document furnished to you by the court, probation officer or Department of Justice collection agent.
- Obey all laws.
- Supervised Probation: Report immediately to Jackson County Community Justice, 1101 West Main, Medford, OR 97501 within 24 hours of your sentencing unless you are in custody. If in custody, report within 24 hours of your release from jail.
- If selected, the defendant will comply with all requirements of treatment courts.

Count 4 : Theft in the Third Degree

Count number 4, Theft in the Third Degree, 164.043, Misdemeanor Class C, committed on or about 06/17/2013. Conviction is based upon a Guilty Plea on 10/09/2013.

Sentence Instructions

Defendant shall:

- conviction only no further sanction

If convicted of a felony or a crime involving domestic violence, you may lose the right to buy, sell, transport, receive, or possess a firearm, ammunition, or other weapons in both personal and professional endeavors pursuant to ORS 166.250, ORS 166.291, ORS 166.300, and/or 18 USC 922(g).
