



## Jackson County Treatment Court (541)776-7171

### ADULT DRUG COURT (ADC)

- ❖ **Participant Fee** - Participants will be required to pay a \$150.00 program fee prior to completion of the program, and a \$107.00 unitary assessment within 90 days of program entry. Participants will also have a \$40.00 per month probation supervision fee, and be required to cover treatment costs not covered by insurance or other means.
- ❖ **Probation Officer** - A Probation Officer will supervise All Adult Drug Court (ADC) participants. Participants will be required to comply with all conditions of probation and to consent to search of self or home at their request.
- ❖ **Adult Drug Court Choice (ADC)** - Applicants will need to declare their intention regarding ADC participation. If they choose ADC, they must schedule an entry of plea.

### COMMUNITY FAMILY COURT (CFC)

- ❖ **Participant Fee** – Participants will be required to pay a \$75.00 fee per family prior to completion of the program. \$10.00 of this \$75.00 fee needs to be paid upon signing in. Clients will need to pay this fee to their treatment provider.
  - ❖ **Children are our priority**- All decisions regarding participants, their treatment and their progress are made in the best interest of children.
  - ❖ **Third-Party Waivers**- All those living in a household with a CFC participant are required to sign a Third-Party Waiver, which guarantees their cooperation with the participant's efforts towards recovery and compliance with Community Family Court.
1. **Treatment** : These state certified treatment providers are partners of Treatment Court:
    - Addictions Recovery Center, 1003 West Main, Medford OR 97501, Phone 779-1282
    - On Track Inc, 221 West Main, Medford OR 97501, Phone 772-1777
  2. **Treatment Level Expectations**: Participants can be required to enter treatment at any level and/or change levels depending on assessment and therapeutic need. Residential treatment can be required depending on assessment and therapeutic need.
  3. **Honesty**: Both programs require complete honesty. Dishonesty will usually result in sanctions.
  4. **12 Step Meetings**: All participants, except those currently in residential treatments, must attend a minimum of two verified meetings per week. All participants must obtain a recovery sponsor.
  5. **Random UA's**: All participants will be required to take random UA's at the request of any program or treatment staff: No exceptions! (If a diluted UA is received or if a participant fails to provide a UA, it is considered positive.)
  6. **Sanctions**: Non-compliance sanctions may include work crew, community service, court days, jail or any other sanction deemed appropriate.
  7. **Ex parte Communication, Waiver of Rights, Termination from program**
  8. **Staffing-Role of Attorney**: Participant cannot have pending charges with the court.
  9. **Irrevocable Decision**: After deciding to enter a treatment court, only the judge decides when the participant leaves.
  10. **Time in the Program**: Treatment court will take a minimum of 18 months for graduation.
  11. **Court Attendance**: Attendance at court as scheduled by the Judge.

- Community Family Court (CFC) hearings are held Tuesday 1:00-5:00PM, Courtroom 101 at the Juvenile Services Building.
- Adult Drug Court (ADC) hearings are held Monday 2:00-5:00PM Courtroom 101 at the Jackson County Juvenile Building, 609 West 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Medford, OR .
