Clarifications for Linn County: December 3, 2012

Email notices and documents: beginning next week certain orders and judgments will be sent to external users by email as well as notices of court events. You will know that it comes from the court and that it is a notice or order because the “from” address will be hearing_scheduled@ojd.state.or.us (Please note that this address is “hearing_scheduled@ojd.state.or.us” – unfortunately it has an underscore in it which does not appear when it is converted to a hyperlinked address.)

If you can create a rule in your email system (and most systems allow this) you can divert all mail from this address to a single folder to keep better track of notices from the court.

Court Access To Case Information and Documents

We are now one week away from implementation of Oregon Ecourt in Linn County on December 10, 2012. There have been a number of messages going out from the Judicial Department and this Court concerning access to case information and court “file” documents. This message is an effort to clarify this and correct one or more errors in past communications.

As of Monday, December 10, 2012, the public will no longer be able to view Linn County information in OJIN on-line. After that date the public (including all external users, attorneys and agencies) will need to come to the courthouse to view the status of any case or any documents in a case.

Our current expectation is that by December 31, 2012 the public, including all external users, will have some access to basic information about a case

similar (but not identical) to what is now available through OJIN but through the Odyssey on line system. If you are an OJIN-on line subscriber you will have access to this information.

The more difficult date to predict is when external users will have access to see the actual documents in a case file. We do not currently have a date certain for this. The very earliest it is likely to happen is April 2013 but it could be delayed until a date later in 2013.

We have been asked if we will type up lists of judgments entered or other information and send them to parties. The answer is that we cannot do that. Our staff will be consumed with learning and operating an entirely new system and there is not time to perform custom reports for anyone.

We appreciate your cooperation and patience during this transition. By the beginning of the year you should have access to the same information you know have access to through OJIN. By the end of next year you will have access to much more of the case file on line except in certain confidential case types. We will send out more information on that as it becomes available.
