RE: Certification Process Fee Increase

This memo is to inform the general public that the Oregon certified court interpreter certification process fees will increase, effective July 2, 2009.

Chief Justice Order No. 08-079 was signed on December 19, 2008, increasing the fees for the interpreter credential due to higher costs in administrative and examination rating services.

The fees will increase as follows:
