) ORDER DESIGNATING "REGISTER" IN
) OREGON CIRCUIT COURTS AND OREGON
) TAX COURT

I HEREBY ORDER, pursuant to ORS 1.002 and ORS 7.095, that:

1. This order supersedes CJO 90-129.
2. ORS 7.020 and ORS 305.485 require the Oregon circuit courts and the Oregon Tax Court to maintain a "register." Pursuant to ORS 7.095 and CJO 86-36, these court records are kept by the use of electronic data processing equipment, with entries made in an electronic case information system and a successor system. This Order describes what constitutes the "register" for purposes of ORS 7.020 and ORS 305.485 and any other statutes referring to the "register" of the Oregon circuit courts or the Oregon Tax Court.
3. Before an Oregon circuit court or the Oregon Tax Court moves its register to a successor case information system, and except as provided in paragraph 5, the court's "register" is the information
 - a. Displayed using the command code "DCAS", or
 - b. Printed using the command code "PCAS".
4. After an Oregon circuit court or the Oregon Tax Court moves its register to a successor case information system, the court's "register" is the information displayed or printed in the case summary.
5. The State Court Administrator shall document and make available to the public the date that each Oregon circuit court and the Oregon Tax Court moves its register to a successor case information system.
6. All existing state court registers and any data transferred to a successor case information system after an Oregon circuit court or the Oregon Tax Court moves to a successor system continue to have the same effect as before the effective date of this order.
7. This order takes effect immediately.
