Six-Month Post-Graduation Program

Treatment as/if directed by counselor; minimum 3 recovery support meetings per week (NA/AA/Other); regular contact with sponsor/mentor; minimum 1 monitored UA per month; 1 contact with PO per month (or as directed by PO); court every month; keep court informed of housing/employment status; & maintain service activities i.e. parent teacher conferences/family events, etc.



Polk County Drug Court began 7/11/05.

Polk County Drug Court is structured to accept both front-end and back-end offenders. Participants are either charged in a new criminal case or with a probation violation (PV). Upon successful completion, new charges or PVs are dismissed. The total program length is a minimum of 12 to 18 months, depending on the time needed to complete the three-phase program. An additional 6 month post-graduation program is required. Polk County Drug Court is a collaborative effort between the Polk County Circuit Court, District Attorney's Office, Indigent Defense Attorney, Polk County Community Corrections, Valley Professional Counseling

and police agencies. Drug court involves frequent court appearances, random drug testing as well as group and individual counseling. The court awards incentives for compliant behavior and imposes sanctions for negative behavior. Drug court participants are required to: **participate in appropriate drug treatment, random urinalysis, immediate sanctions, incentives, obtain Oregon Driver's License, GED, 12-step support meetings (NA/AA/Other), weekly meetings with probation officers, counselors, parenting classes, job-training program, and attend drug court every Monday at 2:00 p.m. A participant must have a minimum of 180 days consecutive clean/sober time in the program to graduate with a continuing plan for post graduate aftercare in place.**

Drug Court Phases:

Phase I: Detox/Stabilization Period

Min. 3 treatment groups per week; appointment w/counselor each week; min. 1 monitored UA's per week; Call UA line M-F; min. 3 recovery support meetings per week (NA/AA/Other); min. 1 contact with PO per week inc.; 1 random home visit per month; & court every week. To be eligible for advancement to Phase 2, participants must: be making payment efforts towards Polk County Community Corrections financial obligations; be current in your \$25.00 monthly drug court fees; be recommended by Staffing Team for Phase Advancement; have an approved sponsor; & min. 60 days consecutive clean/sober in the program.

Phase II: Intensive Outpatient Treatment

Min. 3 treatment groups per week; appointment w/counselor each week; min 1 monitored UAs per week; call UA line M-F; min. 3 recovery support meetings per

week (NA/AA/Other); 1 contact with PO every other week; 1 random home visit per month; & court every week. To be eligible for advancement to Phase 3, participants must: be making payment efforts towards Polk County Community Corrections financial obligations; be current in your \$25.00 monthly drug court fees; complete the requirements above; min. 120 days consecutive clean/sober in the program; have a job or be enrolled in an approved job-training program; & be recommended by Staffing team for Phase Advancement.

Phase III: Recovery/Socialization Phase

Treatment groups per week as directed by counselor; appointment w/counselor each week; min 1 monitored UA's per week; call UA line M-F; 1 contact with PO per month (or as directed by PO); 3 support meetings per week; court every other week; all court fees, Polk County Community Corrections fees and drug court fees paid in full; complete the requirements above; & min/180 days
