PRESIDING JUDGE ORDER

No. 06-005

THIS MATTER COMING BEFORE THE COURT, reference being made to those individuals released from the custody of law enforcement authority for alleged crimes involving victims; therefore,


IT IS ORDERED that any individual released on an agreement to appear before the Court at a later date include the Special Provision of "Defendant shall have no contact with the alleged victim(s);"

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that any individual released on an agreement for alleged crimes involving victims shall include the Special Provision of "Defendant shall not leave the State of Oregon for thirty (30) days;"

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the special "no contact" provision remain in effect for a period of thirty (30) days unless the State of Oregon, by and through the respective District Attorney, or deputy thereof, has filed a criminal case with the Circuit Court of this judicial district. If the District Attorney's Office has not filed a case with the Circuit Court within thirty (30) days from the date of execution of the agreement, the "no contact" provision will expire, thus becoming void.
