THIS MATTER COMING BEFORE THE COURT, reference being made to those individuals that are scheduled for trial before jury or a court trial while being in the care and custody of a physically confining correctional institution; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that any individual scheduled for trial before jury or a court trial shall be ordered to be transported by the State, specifically the District Attorney or his Deputies and be made personally and physically available for trial. If the defendant is incarcerated with the Oregon Department of Corrections, then the defendant shall be transported by them (see attached sample Order). If the crime is one arising during the defendant's incarceration with the Oregon Department of Corrections, then the defendant shall be transported by the Sheriff in all other cases;

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that for any incarcerated defendant scheduled to be tried before jury, that defendant's counsel shall be responsible for providing civilian clothing to the entity holding the defendant, or as directed by the Sheriff or his representatives. This shall be accomplished at last 48 hours prior to the scheduled commencement of the trial;
