For the purpose of activating the extension of time limitations available under ORCP 10 A and ORS 174.120, I issue this ORDER because of the following emergency condition(s) and service disruption(s):

Due to closure of the Morrow County Courthouse by Morrow County, the Morrow County Circuit Court will be closed at 1:00pm on Thursday, December 24, 2015.

Pursuant to Chief Justice Order 08-071 I order the Morrow County Circuit Court located in the Morrow County Courthouse at 100 Court Street in Heppner, Oregon, closed as follows:

to close all operations beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 24, 2015 until 8:00 a.m. on Monday, December 28, 2015.

to open the following alternate location(s) for the following purposes: Restraining orders and other emergency protective orders may be filed at the Umatilla County Circuit Court offices at 915 S.E. Columbia Drive, Hermiston, Oregon during the court day, from 1:00 p.m. to regular close of business on Thursday, December 24, 2015.

The court will work with the State Court Administrator to advise the following people and authorities as soon as possible:

- Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court
- State Court Administrator
- State and local authorities
- Oregon State Bar and local bar association
- State and local news media

This order takes effect immediately.
