PRESIDING JUDGE ORDER

No. 16-007

**THIS ORDER REPLACES PRESIDING JUDGE ORDER 10-002;**

WHEREAS the Sixth Judicial District has a standing Local Family Law Advisory Committee, (LFLAC) established by statute, currently ORS 3.434; and

WHEREAS the presiding judge is to establish a plan to coordinate the provision of services to families involved in domestic relations or other family court proceedings; and

WHEREAS the makeup of the committee requires the Presiding Judge or his judicial designee, the Trial Court Administrator, and business, social service, community and government representatives who must be knowledgeable in family and family law issues; and

WHEREAS the committee is tasked with assisting the presiding judge in preparing and maintaining a Coordination Plan for Services to Families in Family Law Cases pursuant to ORS 3.434(4); now

THEREFORE, the LFLAC is continued for Umatilla County and created for Morrow County.

The presiding judge, while a *de facto* member of the committee, appoints the Chief Domestic Relations Judge as the judge designate and chair for each LFLAC, and the Trial Court Administrator or Deputy TCA as alternate. The Sixth District Family Law Program Coordinator, the Circuit Court Domestic Relations Clerk or alternate serve on each committee, with other members appointed by separate letters of appointment under this PJO, subject to the modification of or continuation of this order.

The standing members of the committee will include:

1. Domestic Relations Administrative Judge – Chair

2. Trial Court Administrator or designee – Deputy Chair
3. Director, Umatilla County Human Services, or designee
4. Director, Morrow County Human Services (Community Counseling Solutions) or designee
5. Umatilla/Morrow County Mediation coordinator, or designee
6. Director, Oregon State Human Services program, or designee
7. Representative, Oregon Attorney General’s Support Enforcement Division
8. Director, Oregon Legal Aid Services, or designee
9. Assigned Citizen Review Board Manager
10. Circuit Court Family Law Program Coordinator
11. Circuit Court Family Law Clerks
12. Designated and appointed Attorney(s)
13. Designated and appointed professional service providers
14. Designated and appointed community representatives

The current Coordination Plan for Services to Families in Family Law Cases, as approved, is continued as the plan for both counties within the district; and

The LFLAC shall assist the PJ, Chief Domestic Relations Judge and TCA in monitoring and implementation of the plan; and

The LFLAC shall provide to the presiding judge such revisions of the plan as are reasonable and necessary.

ADDITIONALLY, the LFLAC shall recommend annual updates to the 6<sup>th</sup> District Supplemental Local Rules to the TCA by February 1 each year that are considered reasonable and necessary to effectively carry out the plan.
