ORDER SETTING CIRCUIT COURT FEES
AND SUPERSEDING CJO 12-028


By virtue of the authority vested in me as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court by ORS 1.002 (1)(a) and ORS 21.258, and except as provided in ORS 20.140, ORS 21.259, and ORS 408.430, the following fees shall be charged and collected by the circuit courts, commencing January 1, 2014:

| 1. Filing and making entry of an assignment of judgment | \$5.00 |
| 2. Official certificate with signature and seal | \$5.00 |
| 3. Electronically delivering documents or data stored in an electronic format | 15 cents per page |
| 4. Converting paper documents into an electronic format and delivering electronically | 20 cents per page |
| 5. Paper copies of documents | 25 cents per page |
| 6. Converting microfilmed documents into an electronic format and delivering electronically | 45 cents per page |
| 7. Each certification | \$5.00 plus 25 cents per page |
| 8. Each exemplification | \$10.00 plus 25 cents per page |
| 9. Each dishonored check | \$35.00 |
| 10. Courtesy use of fax machine | \$2.00 for first page and \$1.00 for each additional page |
| 11. Audio recording, documents or data on compact disc or other court-provided media | \$10.00 |
| 12. Segregation of confidential personal information or protected personal information when the information already exists in a document in a circuit court case file | \$25 per case and \$1.00 per page |
| 13. Segregation of adoption records and redaction of confidential material | \$25 per case and \$2.00 per page reviewed |

For purposes of this order, "page" means one side of a sheet of paper that is 14 inches or less long and 8.5 inches or less wide. Courts are encouraged to print on both sides of paper. Actual costs for postage, packing, and freight may be charged if originals or copies of records are mailed or shipped to individuals at their request and the shipment exceeds 1 ounce (first-class mail rate), exceeds standard 1 ounce postage because of size, is sent outside the continental United States, or is sent by express or priority delivery or private carrier.

This order supersedes CJO 12-028, dated April 5, 2012.
