

INFORMATION ABOUT YAMHILL COUNTY KID'S 1ST PARENT EDUCATION CLASS

- **KID'S FIRST INFORMATION LINE: 503-434-7530 EXT. 4000**
Unless you have an active family abuse restraining order or a no contact order with yourself and your child's other parent; you do not have to schedule to in advance to attend a class.
- The kid's 1st Education Class is a one-time, 2 1/2 hour learning program that complies with ORS 3.425, and is presented by the Yamhill County Family Law Court Mediators.
- Kid's 1st classes are held twice a month—always on a Friday.
- **FIRST and THIRD Friday of the Month class begins at 1:30PM and ends at 4:00PM**

YOU SHOULD ALWAYS CALL THE KID'S 1ST INFORMATION LINE TO CONFIRM CLASS DATES AND TIMES.

The fee is \$40.00 per parent and is due at the time of the class. **ONLY CASH OR A MONEY ORDER WILL BE ACCEPTED.** No checks. No credit cards.

Once you complete the class you will be given a certificate, which you must **KEEP** as proof of your attendance.

No children, support people, or any person not listed as a party to your case should attend the class with you.

This class is designed to assist parents; to help them understand the stress their child(ren) may be experiencing and to give them methods for helping their child(ren) make the needed adjustments. If you have children under the age of 18 and you or your spouse is filing for:

- Dissolution
- Annulment
- Separation
- Custody
- Parenting Time Enforcement
- Filiation/Paternity or
- Modification

It is mandatory that you and your child's other parent attend a parenting class, that complies with ORS 3.425 (e.g. Kid's 1st).
