

Information About Yamhill County Kids 1st Parent Education Class

Unless you have an active family abuse restraining order or a no contact order with yourself and your child's other parent, you do not have to schedule to attend a class ahead of time.

- The Kids 1st Education Class is a one-time, 2 and 1/2 hour learning program that complies with ORS 3.425, and is presented by the Yamhill County Family Court Mediators.
- Kids 1st classes are held twice a month - ALWAYS on Fridays.
- The FIRST Friday of the Month: class begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 11:30 a.m.
- The THIRD Friday of the Month: class begins at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m.

YOU SHOULD ALWAYS CALL THE KIDS 1ST INFORMATION LINE TO CONFIRM CLASS DATES AND TIMES.

The fee is \$40.00 per parent and is due at the time of class. ONLY CASH OR A MONEY ORDER WILL BE ACCEPTED. No checks. No credit cards.

Once you complete the class you will be given a certificate, which you must KEEP as proof of your attendance.

No children, support people, or any persons not listed as a party to your case should attend the class with you.

This class is designed to assist parents understand the stress their child(ren) may be experiencing and to give them methods for helping their child(ren) make the needed adjustments.

If you have children under the age of 18 and you or your spouse is filing for:

Dissolution (divorce); Annulment; Separation; Custody; Parenting Time (visitation); Filiation (non-married parents); Paternity, or Modification;

It is mandatory that you and your child's other parent attend a parenting class, that complies with ORS 3.425 (e.g. Kids 1st).
