2011

January/February 2011

April 2011

New OJD Websites Goes Live with better navigation and user-friendly links

August 2011

Appellate Court ECM completes launch of ECM workflows for electronic processing - ECM goes live for Court of Appeals and Supreme Court.

July - October 2011

Configuration workshops held to identify statutes, uniform trial court rules, codes, & business processes for Odyssey configuration prior to implementation.
