In compliance with Chief Justice Order No. 20-006, the Oregon Tax Court has taken steps to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Those steps include requiring all court personnel to work from home to the greatest extent practicable and changing the court's day-to-day operations to minimize time spent at the court by personnel and court users.
